Roll Removal

Every year, First Lutheran goes through the process of roll removals. Members that have not been active (either by attending or contributing to the church) in the last two years are purged from our membership rolls. See our membership by-laws listed here:

MEMBERSHIP

There shall be a maintained list of all voting members as defined in the Constitution and updated each year as of December 31st.

B3.02 There shall be a maintained roster of Confirmed and Baptized members, updated each year as of December 31st.

A confirmed member that does not, for a period of two (2) years, partake of Holy Communion, support the church with offerings or does not appear to desire to participate in the life and worship of the congregation, may be contacted by the pastor or pastor's appointed representative from the congregation to encourage him/her to activate his/her membership. If after the second year the confirmed member does not actively participate, his/her name shall be removed from the roster of active members of the congregation but shall be retained on a responsibility list as one who is in need of the congregation's prayers and concern. These records may be maintained by the person(s) designated by the Congregation Council.

B3.04 Upon written request of a member, a letter of that member's membership status with the date of baptism, the date of confirmation, and other appropriate information, if any, shall be provided.

I will be removing all inactive members at the beginning of July. If you wish to remain on our membership rolls, you will need to either attend and/or contribute by July 6. If you have any questions, please contact any council member.
