PONDERINGS FROM PASTOR PATTI

"Only, live your life in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that, ... I will know that you are standing firm in one spirit, striving side by side with one mind for the faith of the gospel." (Philippians 1:27)

These words keep resonating with me since we heard them in our healing service in September. Because when I ask myself where I want to be in my spiritual journey (here at First or in my own heart), I want to be living in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. I want to live in one spirit. I want to live side by side with one mind for the faith of the gospel

Simply put...I want to live as God calls me to live every day...and I want to do that with you. I came here knowing and learning about the difficult decisions and discussions that had happened here. And in the beginning, I might have experienced a bit of anxiety, wondering if I would be able to help you heal this depth of brokenness.

I still don't trust completely that I am good enough...but I DO trust that God is! God is good and big enough to do so much more than we can imagine. And I know that God is here

I heard someone say once that some people are not welcome in heaven. Have you thought about those people who hurt others with words or actions, abuse or are just plain mean? Will they be in heaven? Should we have to see them in heaven? What would I say to someone who has hurt me when I see them in heaven?

Having given some thought to this situation now, I can't emphasize enough how important it is for us to hear these words Paul speaks to the Philippians. "Live your life in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ"...one spirit, side by side, one mind. We love one another in response to God's mission in the world. We forgive one another as we have already been forgiven by the one who created us human and imperfect and broken. But we also can struggle with how to do that when we are hurt so deeply by others. The month of October is the month to Go and...Ask. So, we begin this month by asking, "God, how do we live in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ?"

Blessings this month as we "Ask".
